Application Process

- 1. Applications will be reviewed by SBCC's Committee for Local and Global Engagement. Applications may be submitted at missions@sbcommunity.org.
- 2. The selection process will not be governed by the particular deadlines of the applicant(s).
- 3. We recommend the following process for those seeking support from SBCC:
- 4. Be a member of SBCC for at least 2 years.
- 5. Be a committed, regular member of a homegroup.
- 6. Meet with SBCC's Committee for Local and Global Engagement.

SBCC's Values
